Jaime identified some of the issues that caused the bidding of the second contractstructural issues such as dry-rot, termites, etc. For the added work we were in danger of going over the change order limit (10%) so we upgraded the drawings to full modernization and re-bid the project. 8 new classrooms will be in the new building of the west side of the campus. Jaime showed the members a slideshow rendering of the project.
