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PROPOSITION O PROJECT UPDATES

March 12, 2014 CBOC Meeting

This report provides a status report of projects that are part of the Proposition O Program part of the Capital Facility Financing Plan (CFFP). It is intended to provide information to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC), Board of Trustees, staff and public regarding Proposition O expenditures. Project status is the status around the first of the month that this report is dated.

Financial information is provided in a separate report and on the monthly board agenda item M-1.

The list of projects is divided into Active Projects and Completed Projects (including projects in the close-out process). The active projects are listed in the same order as the CFFP report. Updated project information is highlighed.

ACTIVE PROJECTS

Bonita Vista High School:

This project is completed. Substantial completion was December 18, 2013, and final completion was January 13, 2014. This project is in the warranty period and DSA close-out. The final change order is on the March BOT agenda.

This project is for the design of an artificial track and field, electrical infrastructure for stadium lights, bleachers and restrooms. This project was submitted to DSA on December 26, 2013.

The modernization work is being done in two phases. The non-DSA work (including repainting, reroofing the library, covering the unused student lockers, and adding a storage container for the MPR) is complete. Project 2 has been submitted to DSA and includes, HVAC for room IA3 (science), replacement of HVAC for the music building, restroom renovation at MPR, kitchen and cafeteria upgrades, renovating offices, and accessibility upgrades.

Chula Vista High School:

This portion of the CVH ORG Projects work consists of two major components: new fencing around the perimeter of the K Street parking lot, including ornamental iron fencing in front of the Performing Arts Center and new backstops at the baseball and softball fields. The work is scheduled to be complete in March.

This portion of the CVH ORG Projects consists of cosmetic improvements to 4 classrooms in the 100 and 4 classrooms in the 500 building (mostly painting and flooring). The work is scheduled to begin during spring break and completion is scheduled for the start of school in July 2014.

Construction documents for modernization of special education classrooms in Bldg 600 were submitted to DSA on February 6, 2014. Construction is targeted for completion in early 2015. The design contract amendment for the campus-wide electrical grounding was approved February 25, 2014; this is a separate non-DSA deferred maintenance project that will bid separately.


Design will begin in March 2014. The project consists of upgrades recommended in the seismic review that was completed to investigate cracking in the concrete walls. The cracks are cosmetic but the review recommended upgrades to some structural systems to comply with current codes. The most serious deficiency has already been addressed with the removal of the entrance canopy as part of MOH Project 2.

The classroom building exterior framing is nearly complete. Rough in installation of electric, plumbing, mechanical and fire sprinkler systems are substantially done. Remodeling work is underway to transform the former auto shop into a Parent and Testing Center. At the new Gym the

exterior sheathing, interior framing and the first of two major window installations have been completed. Rough-in for building utilities services continues and will be complete in early March.

Topping-Out ceremony will be in April. Steel studs and joists are currently being installed. The welding of the steel structure has been completed. In wall plumbing, HVAC controls, conduit, window frames, and second floor metal deck are currently being installed. Construction is

scheduled to be complete in fall 2014.

Based on budgetary considerations, it has been determined that the construction of a science classroom at the PAH site is not feasible. The need for science curriculum specific furnishings will be addressed by means of portable science work stations.

Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) Solar Power Projects:

Work is complete at MVH, SUH, OLH, SYH, CPM, and ORH. Phase 2A of solar installations includes BVM, CVM, ELM, RDM, MOM, MVM, and HTH. Work is essentially complete at BVM, CVM, ELM, and MVM, but mobilization was delayed at RDM, HTH, and MOM. RDM and HTH are 80% complete. MOM had to be resubmitted to DSA for approval, which is expected by the end of February 2014. Phase 2B consists of ELH, GJH, HTM, and SOM. The contractor has mobilized at ELH and SOM.

District Maintenance completed restoration of the outfield and installation of Turface soil conditioner on the infield. District Planning coordinated installation of a new outfield fence (South Bay Fence), an ADA path of travel (Pave Pros), and installation of power to the field and home dugout on Feb 17, 2014 (Farnum Electric). Burkett & Wong designed structural footing details for a scoreboard and submitted plans to DSA February 21, 2014. Bidding will follow DSA approval. Scoreboard installation is expected to be completed two months after DSA approval.

Construction documents were approved by DSA on October 29. The project is out to bid and bids were opened on March 6, 2014.



The bids for this project were opened on March 10, 2014 and being processed by the District. The bid was under budget. The project is scheduled for completion by the start of school in July 2014.

CVH Interim Housing (*BCA*, *Turner*, 100%) – Closed without certification on 7/21/2011. Final documents will be submitted to DSA.

Fire Alarm Upgrades – CVM, HTH, MOH (RRC/FBA, Time and Alarm Systems, 100%, CO rate minus 2.4%) – Complete and in the close-out phase with DSA.

Fire Alarm Upgrades – NCM (LPA, McCarthy, 100%) – Complete and in the close-out phase with DSA.

GJH Health Clinic Upgrades (*Matalon, Kinsman Construction, 100%*). In order to expand operation hours from part-time to full-time, the clinic needed to add an office, utility room and upgrade electrical outlets and a new HVAC unit.

HTH Interim Housing (*RRC*, *Fordyce*, 100%) – Final documents will be submitted to DSA for closeout. Because the interim housing has been removed, DSA may elect to void the project.

HTH Title IX Field Upgrades & Restroom (RRC, Western Rim, 100%) – Final documents have been submitted to DSA for closeout.

MOM Project 1: (*LPA*, *Balfour Beatty*, 100%) – Construction was substantially complete on July 23, 2013, and open for the start of school on July 24th. Soon after, SUHSD removed 15 modular units from the site. The Notice of Completion was filed on October 24, 2013. The project consisted of 18 new classrooms, a library, counseling center, cafeteria, and stage – all designed to LEED platinum, the highest level of sustainability. It also features the first installation of a "displacement ventilation" HVAC system in the District.

MVH Project 1 (*LPA*, *Augustine*, 100%) – Project is complete except for DSA certification. Documents will be submitted and we are awaiting DSA approval of final change orders.

MVH Title IX Field Upgrades (RNT, Nuera, 100%) – Project is complete except for DSA certification.

NCM Project 1 (LPA, RC Construction, 100%) – The project is complete and occupied. Final documents are being submitted to DSA for close-out.

SOH Project 1 (*LPA*, *HAR*, *terminated on 6/21/11*) – HAR Construction was terminated on June 21, 2011. In litigation.
