



- A number of Board meetings were held since the last CBOC meeting in November.
- At the November 20th meeting at SUH, all items passed.
- At the December 18th meeting, all items passed except F-3, the CFFP update was not addressed due to time.

 Presentations were made at the joint CBOC/BOT meeting on January 12th

- E-25 CFFP Prop O budget adjustments:
 - NCM Project 2: increase by \$370,000 for the parking lot to assure funding for both the parking lot and PE field restoration.
 - New \$350,000 budget for ceiling fans at various sites for classrooms without air-conditioning.
 - Fire Alarm Upgrade Group 1: decrease budget by \$100,000
 - Contingency: net decrease by \$620,000 Contingency is now 4.2% of remaining expenses.

- Item E-26: Out of 8 consultant items 1 new contract and 1 amendment pertain to Prop O.
 - Hire Knowland Construction for Inspector-of-Record services for the NCM P2 Parking Lot project.
 - Amend the contract with Ninyo and Moore for special testing services at the NCM P2 Parking Lot project.



- Item E-28: Out of 4 change orders 3 pertain to Prop O.
 - BVM Modernization CO#4 for Fordyce Construction.
 CO rate is 8.66%
 - Technology Infrastructure CO#5 for Standard Electronics. CO rate is 4.38%
 - NCM P2 CO #10 for McCarthy Building Companies, Inc.
 CO rate is decreased to 8.12%

BVM Modernization 2 A/E: IBI Group Design: DSA Approved

Contractor: Fordyce Construction Construction: 100% Change Order Rate: 8.66%

 Final work on the freezer unit was completed over winter break.



- Hilltop MS 28 ceiling fans for building 400 should have been completed by the end of the year but supply problems have delayed completion. "Any day now" is what Maintenance keeps hearing from the contractor.
- Mar Vista HS Project 2 Building 600 Modernization –
 Whillock Contracting, Inc. is awarded the contract.
 Construction began in November. Demolition is mostly complete and underground work is under construction.
 Occupancy is expected in fall 2015.



• The contractor missed the winter break deadline and expects to be complete by the end of the month.


SOM Project 1C – MPR & Bldg D	A/E: RNT	Design: 95% in DSA

 The project received DSA approval and was out to bid when DSA voided their approval because the architect had let his license lapse. The project must be resubmitted to DSA and the architect will be responsible for all extra fees incurred.



 Although the architect has renewed his license, he has been unresponsive to all forms of contact. The district is evaluating options including replacing the architect.





