

- Mar Vista HS Project 2 Building 600 Modernization –
 Whillock Contracting, Inc. is 25% complete. Change order
 rate is 0.19%. Demolition, underground work, and rough
 framing are complete. Rough electrical and plumbing are
 in progress. Roofing is scheduled for the spring break.
 Occupancy is expected in fall 2015.
 - Mar Vista HS Project 2 Electrical Upgrade –
 Precision Electric is 40% complete. Change order rate is 4.85%. Underground and building conduit work was completed during the winter break. The contractor will be back during spring break to complete the wiring part of the project. Final completion is expected in summer 2015

SWEETWATER

- Montgomery HS Gym Structural Upgrades
 - The project was approved by DSA on February 11th.
 Project will bid in April with construction scheduled for summer.



- National City Middle School Project 2
 - New Parking Lot is under construction.
 - The burned restroom building has been moved to L St.
 - Restoration of the fields is pending removal of the restroom building and security resident. The Board approved a settlement agreement. The site has requested additional physical educational facilities that may require a budget increase.





- National City Middle School Project 2
 - Willock Construction is 99% complete. Change order rate is 5.01%. Punchlist items will be completed in March.
 Staff will move in over spring break.
- Southwest Middle School Project 1C (MPR & Bldg D)
 - Bidding in March and construction beginning in April.
 Completion expected in early 2016.


